

TO BE A TEXAS ASSISTED LIVING MANAGER

To be an assisted living manager in the state of Texas you need to complete a 24-hour AL Manager's Course in the first year and maintain 12 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) annually in subsequent years. Memory care manager's are required to take an additional 6 CEUs annually, specific to memory care/dementia for a total of 18 CEUs in subsequent years.

There is also Annual Mandatory Training for Assisted Living Facilities with HHSC:

The required 24-Hour AL Manager's course is broken down into two parts,

Part 1: 8 hours of Texas Regulations (Required within the first 3 months of hire)

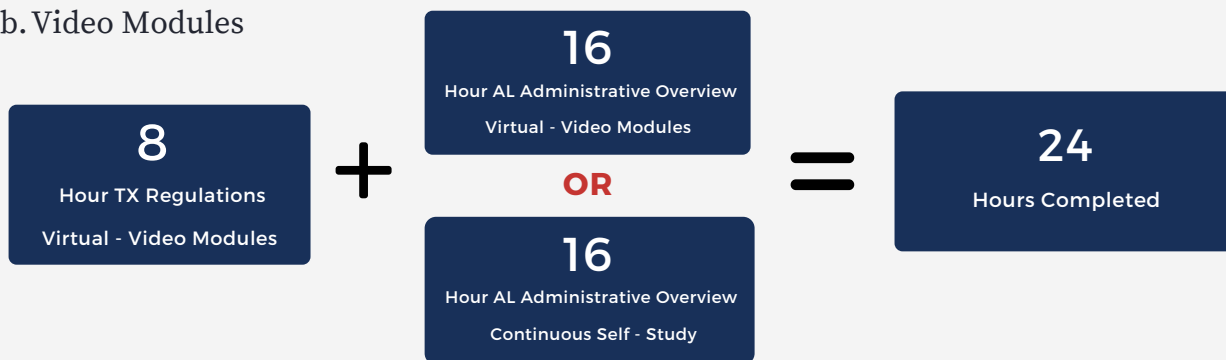
Part 2: 16 hours of Administrative Overview (Required within the first year of hire)

Texas Regulations for Staff Training - 26 TAC §553.253

Please note: Texas does not mandate licensing or certification to be an Assisted Living Manager, however, you must provide evidence you completed the required training.
