



Proposition 14: Funding The Dementia Prevention and Research Institute

SB 5 established the Dementia Prevention and Research Institute (DPRIT). Voting YES for Proposition 14 on November 4th will enable funding over the next 10 years. DPRIT will partner with Texas' universities and medical research facilities as grant partners. DPRIT will support research into causes of and treatment for dementias, including but not limited to Alzheimer's Disease.
